What to Expect

In our program, you will learn how to care for individuals who require ongoing support due to age, illness or injury. You will gain experience working in a variety of different settings such as long-term care facilities, and in clients' homes. You will help individuals live their lives more independently through a patient-centered, holistic approach to care.

Course Structure

Our PSW Certificate Training Program is broken out into two phases - after Phase 1 is completed, you will be qualified to work with SE Health as a Home Support Worker, while you continue your PSW training.

Phase 1 - PSW1 Module and HSW Requirement:

During your PSW training, you will learn the fundamentals of being a Support Worker. The first four weeks of this phase is virtual learning, scheduled Monday-Friday from 11AM - 4PM. Once you have completed your online classes, you will spend one week working in the community alongside a mentor. Students are compensated for attending class during this phase of the program so that they will never go without a paycheque.



Phase 2 - PSW Certification & Training:

This phase will start with 11 weeks of instructor-led online classes (scheduled Monday-Friday, 11AM-4PM), followed by three weeks of hands-on, in-person skills development training. The last portion of your PSW training will include a three-week practicum placement. During this phase, we offer students employment with SE Health as an HSW. This allows you to earn an income as you work towards your full certification.

Working as a Direct Care Provider

Support Workers play an essential role in our healthcare system. They provide compassionate, personalized care to individuals and families with defined healthcare needs. Home Support Workers (HSW) vs. Personal Support Workers (PSW)

Starting week 6 you will be qualified to work for SE Health as a Home Support Worker while you complete your PSW Training. What is the difference?

Both Home Support Workers (HSW's) and Personal Support Workers (PSW's) make a positive impact in people's lives. Although HSW's and PSW's share similarities, there are marked differences between these two roles. HSW's do not require as much certification and training as PSW's. As an HSW, you will focus on clients with less complicated health care needs - those who are able to function more independently. PSW's care for less stable clients, with higher levels of dependence. Here's a look at some of the duties you would perform in each of these roles:

- Meal Planning & Preparation
- Companionship, Emotional Support
- Light Housekeeping Tasks
- Bathing, Personal Hygiene, Safe Bathroom Use

Personal Support Worker

- Medication Reminders
- Lifting & Transferring
- Bathing, Personal Hygiene, Safe Bathroom Use
- Palliative Care
